

## Plugin AJAX Load

This [wiki plugin](#), introduced in [Tiki14.1](#), can be used to load HTML into a wiki page, from another page on the same site or an external site (when used in combination with the `access_control_allow_origin` pref on **Control Panels -> General -> Settings**) using AJAX. It also used to include the body of another web page in a wiki page into an HTML IFRAME tag.

### Parameters

Plugin Manager error: ajaxload plugin not found

### Examples

#### Basic Example

```
{AJAXLOAD(url="http://example.com/tiki-index.php" selector="#page-data")}alert(data.length + " bytes of data received"); {AJAXLOAD}
```

#### Superfish menu from a structure

In order to make page loading faster you can use `AJAXLOAD` to load a menu from a structure asynchronously. Put the menu in a module in a page (here called "structure menu test") and add this to a *wiki enabled* custom module (here called "test\_structure\_menu") and assign it to the topbar module zone (**⚠ warning:** if you leave out the `{literal}` tags you will probably make your tiki unusable and will need to edit the database to get it back!).

```
{literal}{AJAXLOAD(url="tiki-index_raw.php?page=structure+menu+test" selector="#structure_menu")} setTimeout(function () {$("#mod-test_structure_menu").superfish();}, 500); {AJAXLOAD}{/literal}
```
