Use this [wiki plugin](#), introduced in [Tiki5](#), to invoke a [BigBlueButton](#) in a page.

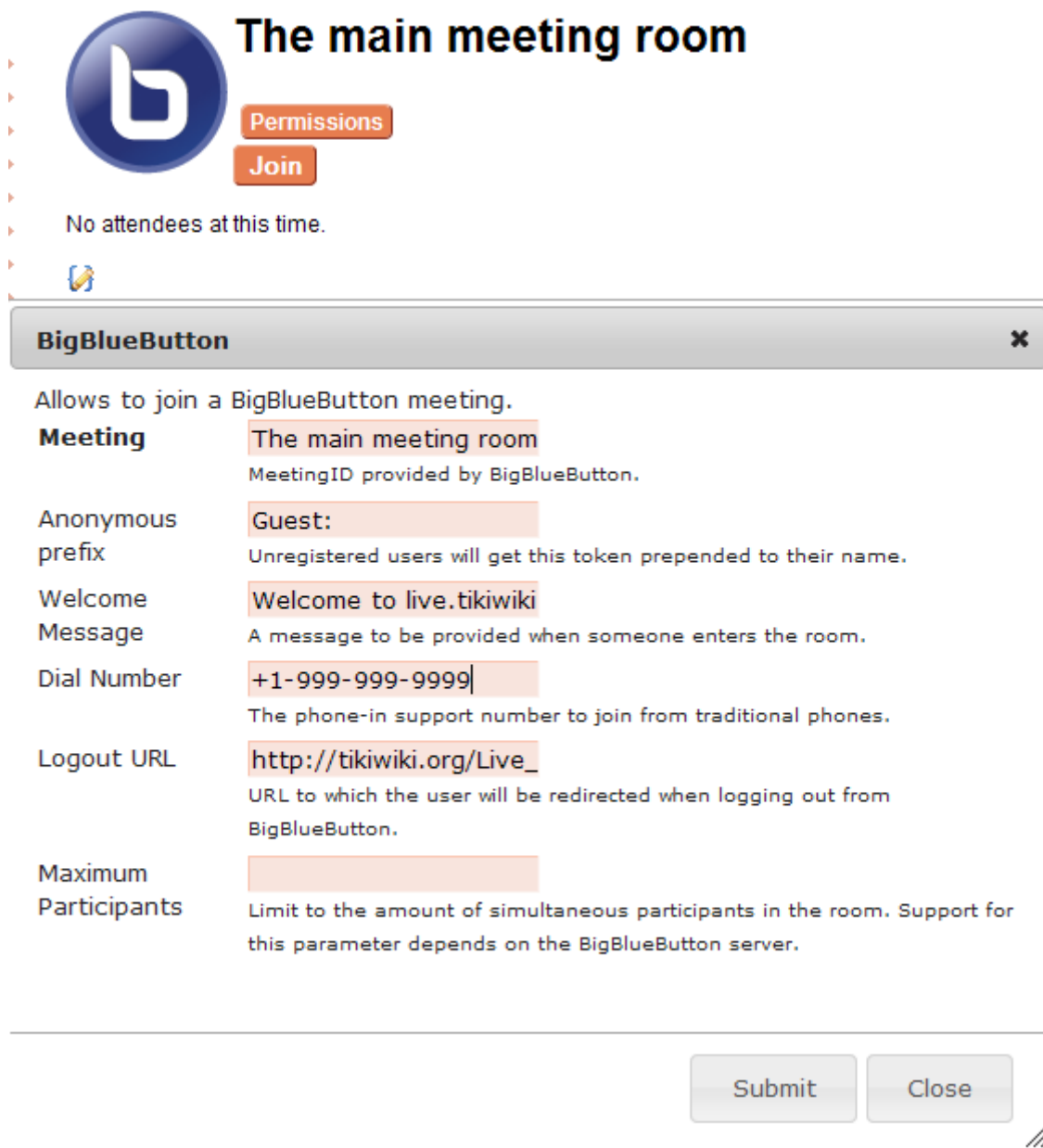
