The tracker must have the following fields:

Field	Type	Purpose
<i>question</i>	text field	the question
<i>answer</i>	text field	correct answer
<i>option a</i>	text field	false answer
<i>option b</i>	text field	false answer
<i>option c</i>	text field	false answer
<i>valid</i>	checkbox field	indicates that the tracker item is to be used as a quiz item

The jQuery Sortable Tables feature must be activated for the sort feature to work.
