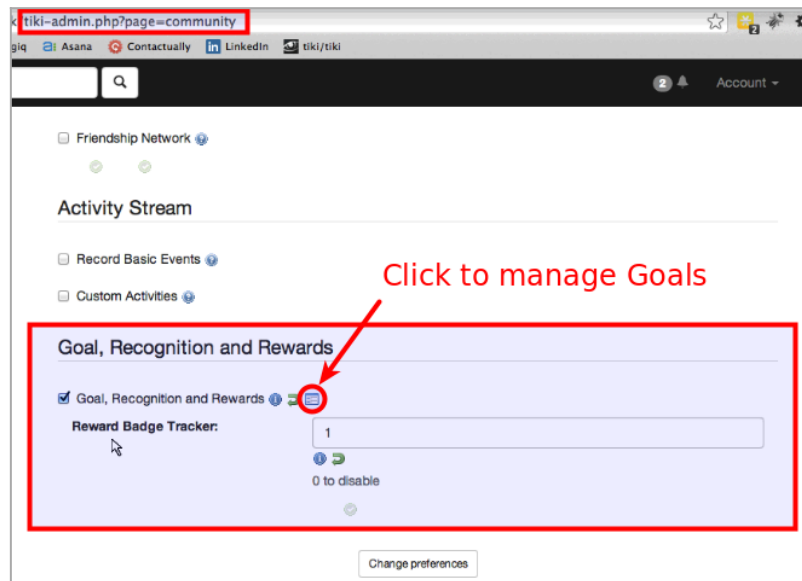

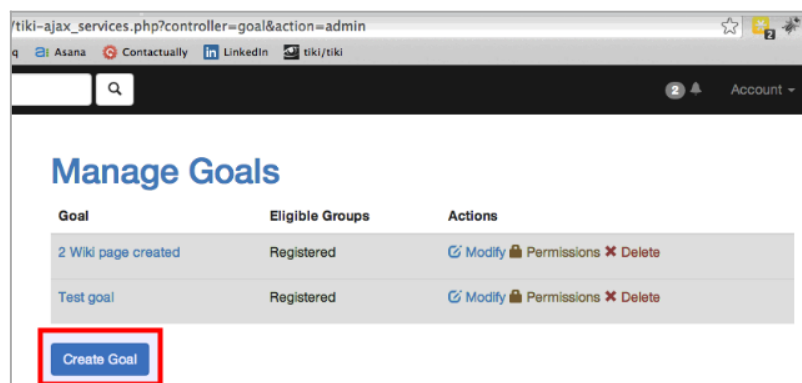
1.1. Enable the feature

Enable the feature in "Admin home > Community"



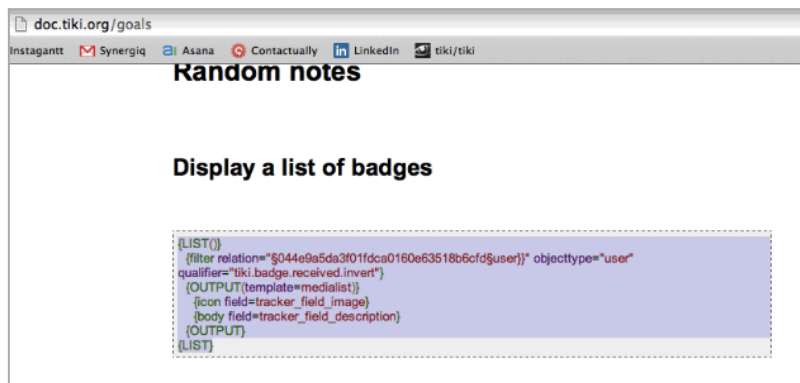

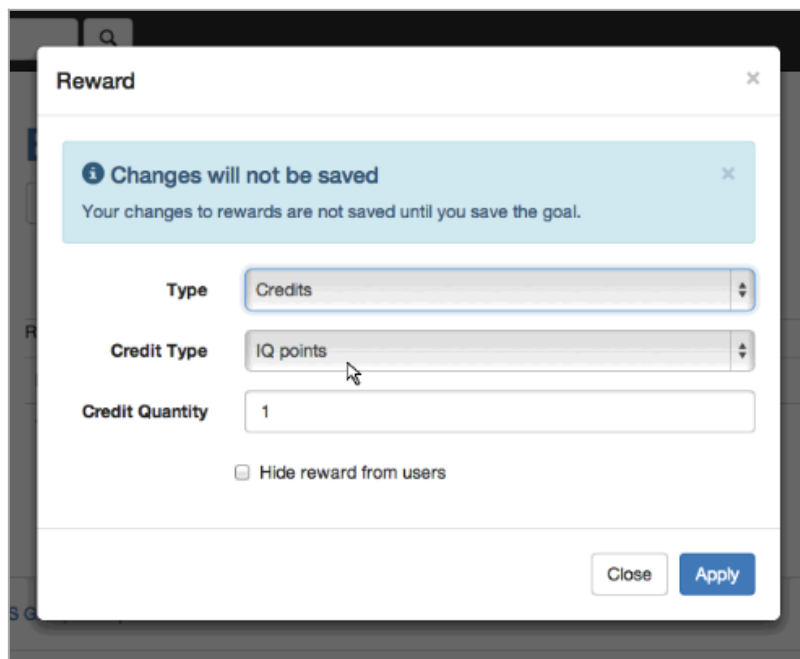
And then you can use plugin List to show that image wherever you need in your site. See the example at the documentation page for Badges:
